Item # 3:

Firm must refer to and read Exhibit I, pages 8-31 of the RFP to find the descriptions of the following items 1-37, found in the revised price sheet below.. The item #s found on pages 8-31 will not coincide with the numbering in the revised price sheet below. You must look for the description for each item to match it against the descriptions for items below # 1- # 37.

Item # 4:

The following description is being ADDED as part of Exhibit I.

Abandoned Vessel and Vehicle Removal:

Under this contract, work shall consist of the all labor, equipment, fuel, traffic control costs, and other associated costs necessary for the removal and haul-out of eligible vessels, both on land or marine, and vehicles in areas identified and approved by the City Contract Administrator. The removed eligible vehicles will be hauled to a City Contract Administrator-approved staging area and subsequently disposed of at a City approved Final Disposal Site. The removal, transportation, and disposal required for abandoned vessel and vehicle removal includes obtaining all necessary Local, State, and Federal Handling Permits and operating in accordance with all Local, State, and Federal regulations.

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Item # 5:

The following description is being revised. This description below replaces the description of Item # 10. ROW White Goods Debris Removal, found on pages 15-16 of Exhibit I for this RFP.

ROW White Goods Debris Removal

Under the contract, work shall consist of all labor, equipment, fuel, traffic control costs and other associated costs necessary for the collection of white goods from the ROW, , transportation to a City approved DMS, decontamination, and transportation to a City approved final disposal site. White goods containing refrigerants must first have such refrigerants removed by the Contractor's qualified technicians prior to mechanical loading. Payment for removal of refrigerants will be made under separate pay item entitled "Freon Management".

White goods can be collected without first having refrigerants removed if the white goods are manually placed into a hauling vehicle with lifting equipment so that the elements containing refrigerants are not damaged.

White goods are banned from landfill disposal in the state of Florida, but are accepted for recycling.

- a. The removal, transportation and recycling of eligible white goods includes obtaining all necessary local, state and federal handling permits and operating in accordance with all rules and regulations of local, state and federal regulatory agencies.
 - i. All white goods containing food items shall be decontaminated in accordance with local, state and federal law prior to recycling.
- b. The Contractor shall recycle all eligible white goods in accordance with all rules and regulations of local, State and federal regulatory agencies.
- c. Refrigerant containing items will have such refrigerants removed prior to mechanical loading or will be manually loaded and hauled to a City approved final disposal site.
