Project Description: The City’s Main Fire Station is over 40 years old and has outlived its useful life as well as exceeded the capacity and changes to the operations of the Fire Rescue Department. The new facility will include the City’s Emergency Operations Center, four drive-through bays, Fire Administrative Offices, Fire Inspection offices, training space, and living quarters.



PROJECT PROGRESS: FEBRUARY 2017

- East side of the fire station is verticle, with architectural concrete beginning to be placed
- Columns for apparatus bay are formed. Second floor deck has been poured.
- Architectural concrete mockup has been approved, forms for the isolated columns are being installed currently, and columns have been poured.
- Privacy wall is complete
- Plumbing, Electrical, and Mechanical rough on the interior are progressing
- Interior wall framing has commenced
